



↑ What Does POP Do?


POP raises money to support all programs and the school. It manages all of the club/sport boosters and raises money specifically for things like Project Grad

Joining POP only costs \$25.00. This goes a long way in supporting the school



We want to continue to create a school wide branding program to include our buildings





This represents thousands of hours of lost instruction for students.








PHS CELL PHONE POLICY




BEST TIMES TO DROP OFF AND PICK UP

INGRESS AND EGRESS AT PHS

Do not go down the Bus lane at anytime!!!!!

Drop Off



Gates open at 7:00 am but you can drop off 10 minutes before that.

Data analysis: Drop off before 7:10 am to avoid the traffic. Do not allow your student to leave your car while you are in the street or at an intersection for safety reasons.

Pick Up




Parents start lining up around 1:40 pm to 1:50 pm.
